Our Training & Professional Development Services

For more than 35 years we have been building the knowledge, capacity and competency of professionals to prevent and respond to sexual violence. People who have experienced sexual violence do recover with the help of informed, trained support professionals.

We offer a range of training and supervision services to support the prevention of sexual assault and to recognise and respond effectively with sensitivity.

Training is delivered by industry professionals who have a range of relevant education and employment histories. Learnings from their direct practice are shared with participants to further enhance knowledge and approach.

Our training is developed using an informed evidence base, and we continuously evaluate, reflect and strengthen our training based on participant feedback and new and emerging research.

Workshops

We deliver training to professionals, university students and community members who are seeking to become more knowledgeable about trauma-informed support responses.

Workshop examples include:

- Responding to disclosures of sexual assault in children and adolescents
- Trauma Informed therapeutic responses when working with children and adolescents
- Preventing and responding to vicarious trauma
- Identifying and responding to problem sexual behaviours in children and adolescents
- Assessing and responding to problem sexual behaviours in children with a disability
- Developing and implementing safety plans for children displaying problem sexual behaviours
- Positive behaviour management for child and adolescents with a disability and/or ASD

Tailored Training Packages

Alongside our training program, we offer fee for service training specifically designed to meet organizational needs. Fee for service training can be delivered in 1.5 hours, 3 hours or a full day session.

Debriefing and incident support

We can also provide debriefing following an incident to support staff wellbeing.

Supervision

Supervision of professionals for professional development is a fee for service and can be provided at your organization, at our office or another location.

Secondary Consultation

Our Intake and Response Team welcomes enquiries by professionals and practitioners needing advice or guidance. If you are working with someone impacted by sexual assault or a child / adolescent displaying problem sexual behaviours, we can provide assistance. Our Intake and Response Team can also provide information about our services and programs to consider when making a referral. Secondary consultations are provided to various people across the Loddon region such as health professionals, educators, community workers, child and family services, private psychologists and police.
